

ORDINANCE NO. 2516

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS ON THE STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SILVER LAKE; PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND CODE PROVISIONS

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Silver Lake, Kansas:

Section 1. OPERATION OF MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS.

(a) "Micro utility truck" means any motor vehicle which is not less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, of not more than 160 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and fluids, of more than 1,500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as originally manufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab. For purposes of this ordinance, this definition will be interpreted in light of the definition under state law, K.S.A. §8-1494 and any amendments thereto.

(b) Micro utility trucks may be operated upon the streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the City, subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, and the prior ordinances of the City.

(c) All provisions of Ordinance No. 2500, regarding work site utility vehicles shall apply to the operation, use and registration of micro utility trucks, and any person operating any micro utility truck shall fully comply with that ordinance.

Section 2. JURISDICTION. The provisions of this ordinance shall also apply to all land and water either within or outside the boundary of the city over which the city has either exclusive jurisdiction, concurrent jurisdiction, or real property ownership, and the air space above such land or water.

Section 3. REPEAL. All Ordinances and City Code provisions of the City of Silver Lake, Kansas, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. PUBLICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be published one time in the official city newspaper and shall take effect and be in force from and after said publication.
