## RESOLUTION 2023-03

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the City of Silver Lake, Kansas that fireworks as defined in Section 7-301 of the Code of the City of Silver Lake, Kansas may be lawfully discharged within the corporate limits of the City only between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M. on June 27<sup>th</sup>, June 28<sup>th</sup>, June 29<sup>th</sup>, June 30<sup>th</sup>, July 1<sup>st</sup>, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 and between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and midnight on July 3<sup>rd</sup> and July 4<sup>th</sup>, and between 9:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M. July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Furthermore, fireworks may be lawfully discharged between the hours of 11:50 P.M., December 31, 2023 and 12:10 A.M. on January 1, 2024.

In the event of a county wide burn ban, the lighting of fireworks within the city will be prohibited.
